A review committee composed of faculty from CALS departments will evaluate applications and make recommendations for awards. Decisions will be made by February 10, 2015.

Please include the following in your application

- 1. Name
- 2. CALS graduate program and year
- 3. Major professor
- 4. Brief description of graduate research project
- 5. Organic conference you wish to attend and a brief description on how attending it will support and/or enhance your research
- 6. Brief description of any involvement you have had in organic agriculture research, outreach, and education
- 7. Costs you are seeking to have covered by the Blobaum fund (Please submit a proposed budget on the attached expense report)
- 8. Alternate sources of funding for your travel, if any
