Position Summary:

The University of Wisconsin-Madison, College of Agricultural and Life Sciences, and the University of Wisconsin-Extension, Cooperative Extension Division, invite applicants for the position of Associate Dean for Extension and Outreach. As Associate Dean, the individual has responsibility to provide leadership for the organization, content, and effectiveness of Extension and outreach programs in the college. The individual in the position reports jointly to the Dean of Cooperative Extension (CE) within the University of Wisconsin Extension (UWEX) and the Dean of the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences (CALS) at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. The successful candidate will have UW-Madison faculty status in a department in the college.

Unlike previous iterations of this position, the successful incumbent will focus on CALS campus-based outreach leadership that involves UW-Extension and others, without county-based or program area leadership.

Principal duties:

- 1) Provide visionary leadership and planning for CALS Extension/outreach priorities and alignment with those of CE.
- 2) Provide leadership for matters relating to CE budget and personnel for all Extension appointments in CALS, including managing inter-institutional agreements and building support for revenue sources for Extension and outreach activities.
- 3) Represent CALS to external stakeholder constituencies and to Extension/outreach partners.
- 4) Encourage and support development of new evidence-based outreach programming that addresses emerging issues and opportunities and emphasizes the CALS and CE value proposition and priorities to stakeholders in Wisconsin and beyond.
- 5) Encourage innovation and excellence in Extension/outreach programming within CALS and ensure that Extension/outreach activities are appropriately assessed in the performance appraisal process for CALS faculty and staff and recognized as an important and integral component of departmental responsibilities.
- 6) Serve as a member of the CALS Administrative Team and other administrative groups as appointed by the Dean of CALS.
- 7) Perform university and community service as appropriate.

Additional Information:

Established in 1889, the college carries out UW-Madison's mission as a land-grant public university through excellence in teaching, research and public outreach across 19 academic fields, ranging from production agriculture to natural resources to social sciences to fundamental life sciences.

Cooperative Extension is one of four UW-Extension divisions, and part of the University of Wisconsin System. Educators work in partnership with people in county, state, federal, and tribal governments; community organizations; volunteers; business; and industry. Our outreach programs, research and assistance involve people, communities and organizations in educational experiences that teach them to apply the latest knowledge and technology to local issues and concerns.
