- Operates M-F, 7:30am-7:30pm during fall and spring UW class sessions. No service on holidays, weekends, winter break, or in summer.
- Shuttle is intended to supplement campus bus and paratransit service for those with mobility issues, whether temporary or permanent. Service is available to UW employees, students, visitors, and affiliates. No pre-registration is required to use this service.
- You may board at any designated fixed route stop or call for pickup at another location within the service boundary. You may request drop-off anywhere within the service boundary. Between fixed route stops the shuttle may travel along any path and will not stop at other bus stops.
- When the shuttle approaches, signal to the driver your interest to board if you are able. The driver will exit the vehicle and do a brief check for riders. If you are worried that you may be passed, call the dispatcher to inform them where you will be waiting so the driver can find you.
- Upon boarding inform driver of your destination and if you require boarding assistance.
- When calling for a pickup, your wait time will be greatly reduced if you can call at least one hour prior to your desired pick up. Pre-scheduling of regular rides is encouraged. Please be prepared to provide your name, a call back #, and desired pickup address/time when you call.
- Real time shuttle locations are available online or via mobile app. The website is at <http://tds1.saucontech.com/portal/index.html> but you will need to call 608-890-1352 or email uwshuttle@badgerbus.com in order to obtain a login.
- This pilot is for the period of one year. The performance and results of the pilot, as well as available funding, will determine if service is extended beyond the first year.
